### MY TWO BUTT SYSTEM

The water butt pump is located in Butt 1. Water flows from the diverter into Butt 2. There is an interconnect pipe between the two butts about 5" above the bottom of the butt. This forms a sediment trap in both butts into which debris can accumulate rather than enter the pump. The position of the interconnect pipe ensures that the water level is always the same in both butts.



THE RAINWATER DIVERTER - Available in black and brown, quite how I managed to buy a grey one beats me - but at least it shows up on the photos

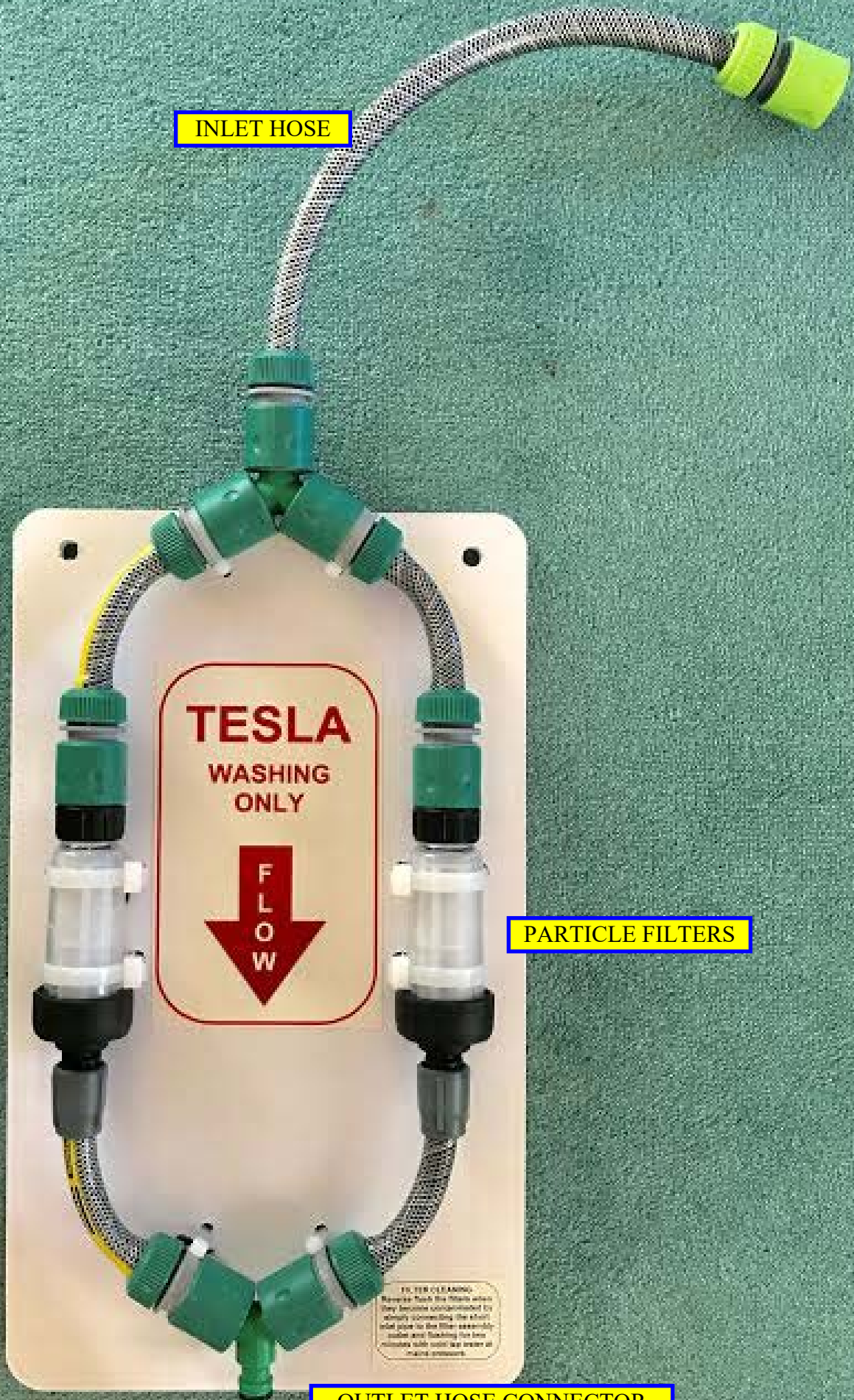


Its useful to know just how full your water butt is. A simple ball float screwed to a glass fibre rod is all you need

The external filter unit, removes any tiny particles that have made it through the pump filter

**FILTER CLEANING:**  
Reverse flush the filters when they become clogged. Do this by simply unscrewing the elbow and pipe in the filter assembly and flushing the line. Reverse side will stop water at main pressure.
